Bishopstrow College is delighted to announce that students graduating from the College in the academic year through to September 2014 secured places at a number of leading independent prep and senior schools, continuing on the successes of previous graduating classes.

During the 2013/14 academic year, c.100 students graduated from the College, broadly spread across the College's three main programmes – Lower College (ages 7-11), Middle College (ages 11-14) and Upper College (ages 14-17). Students represented a diverse range of nationalities, including Angola, China, France, Hong Kong, Italy, Japan, Kazakhstan, Korea (Republic), Malaysia, Pakistan, Poland, Russia, Serbia, Thailand, Turkey and Ukraine.

Leavers from the College's Lower College Programme were able to secure places at some of the UK's leading independent prep schools, including Cottesmore School, Highfield, Packwood Haugh School, St John's Beaumont and The Dragon School. Meanwhile, many Middle College and Upper College leavers successfully secured places at some of the very best independent senior schools in the UK, including Bromsgrove School, Bruton School For Girls, Dulwich College, Epsom College, Queen Ethelburga's, Ruthin School, Rugby School and Woldingham School. Other leavers returned home to continue their studies, with the intention of returning to the UK to continue their studies at a later date.
