Boarding Tutor

This role would suit someone looking for a residential post at the College, initially for a fixed term period September to August, but there may be the possibility to extend the contract.

Main Responsibilities

- Supervise and care for the international boarding students who attend the College.
- Take an active role in ensuring students' welfare and happiness, helping them to develop intellectually, socially and emotionally.

Terms and Conditions

- The hours require flexibility and will be discussed with applicants. Boarding Tutors do not normally supervise students in lessons, so most of the hours occur after school, in the evenings, at wake-up and breakfast time, and at weekends.
- The annual holiday entitlement is 8 weeks, normally to be taken when the College is closed. The College operates a four-term academic year of 44 teaching weeks. The College is therefore open for more weeks per year than most schools and operates throughout July and August.
- All meals are provided when on duty (and may also be taken free of charge whenever the College kitchens are operating). Particular dietary needs are routinely accommodated.
- Ensuite accommodation for sole use and available all year is provided for resident staff.
- A 3% pension contribution is made by the College alongside an employee 5% contribution.
