Many congratulations to our students, who achieved 100% pass rate in the latest round of Cambridge English Language Assessment exams. In the first-stage Key English Test (KET), 40% of students gained a Distinction, with a further 50% awarded a Merit. At the next level up, 50% of students taking the Preliminary English Test (PET) passed with Distinction, while the remaining 50% received a Merit.

Everyone worked extremely hard for these exams, which are internationally recognised qualifications and a vital part of our students' preparation for their destination schools.
