EXAM RESULTS

In 2022, 100% of grades awarded in IGCSEs were A* to C (equivalent to Grades 9-4), with 43% of grades awarded being Grades A* to A (equivalent to Grades 9-7)

Extra-Curricular Programme

The College's Extra-Curricular Programme includes a range of daily sports and evening clubs and activities, designed to foster team spirit and the confidence to integrate with others when students move on from Bishopstrow. Clubs include Crazy Scientist Club, Zumba, chess, debating, bird watching, board games, craft, singing and art.

We also organise a stimulating and varied programme of fully-supervised activities and trips at weekends. These allow students to discover places of cultural, geographical and historical interest or to sample the great outdoors, through walking, hiking and other physical pursuits. Activities, sightseeing and cultural visits provide contexts within which speaking and listening skills are put to the test. They are also great fun and provide memories to last a lifetime.

Support for Destination School Entry

Most of our students intend to study at other boarding schools in the UK when they have completed their course of study. All students enrolled at Bishopstrow can benefit from advice and support in relation to progression to their destination school. We will:

- Liaise with destination schools to ensure that all required information is submitted within the admissions deadlines.
- Arrange practice tests and interviews, giving advice and feedback for those students required to sit entrance examinations and attend interviews.
- Support students in planning, drafting and finalising their personal statement.
