English language teachers provide tuition in Cambridge English exams such as Key, Preliminary and First, as well as in Common Entrance assessment preparation and content and language integrated learning modules. Teachers act as tutors, working with students to set academic targets and supporting learners in meeting them. Teachers also take on a significant responsibility for the safeguarding and welfare of students. As such, the role of English language teacher at Bishopstrow College is very demanding, yet rewarding in many ways.

Experience and Qualifications

We require a degree level qualification and a CELTA or equivalent qualification as a minimum. Applicants must be able to demonstrate good organisational skills, precision in lesson planning and confident, enthusiastic classroom delivery. Experience of teaching Cambridge English exams is desirable, as is experience of working in a busy department where expectations of both students and teachers are high.
