Bishopstrow College is an international boarding school offering English language and academic pathway programmes to prepare international students, aged 7-17, for entry into mainstream boarding schools.

The College operates as a traditional British boarding school, but with an innovative four-term academic year. Students are able to enroll in September, January, March and June, with a fifth start date in July. Students, who do not have English as their first language, are prepared as quickly as possible, from 5 weeks (for those enrolled on the Academic Summer Programme) up to one year, until they are ready to progress to their 'destination school'. The College is accredited by the British Council under the Accreditation UK Scheme and by ISI.

Terms

Part-time, from Monday 20 June, 2022.

This role is initially part-time, but may develop to a full-time position as the College grows.

Lunch is provided free of charge on days of work.
