Bishopstrow Online was launched in March 2020, in response to the coronavirus pandemic, with all students studying remotely through to September 2020, when we reverted to face-to-face and some hybrid delivery.

Following our successful delivery of a wide range of online academic programmes during lockdown and a bespoke online course for those students unable to join us at the start of Term 3, we will again be providing an outstanding online experience for students enrolling at the College during Term 4, which runs from 20 June to 26 August, 2022). **This initiative is in response to the ongoing delays faced by international students in securing a visa to study in the UK.**

Bishopstrow Online at a Glance

Bishopstrow Online offers much more than a remote learning experience. The programme covers academic, cultural, social and boarding preparation. Face-to-face lessons are delivered in live, interactive classrooms by Bishopstrow's professionally qualified teachers. Students are able to interact with their teacher and other students as in a traditional classroom, raising questions, sharing comments or making contributions.

Whilst students will be studiying remotely, they will follow the same timetable as those students on campus, albeit the online timetable will be an abridged version.

Academic Programme

- 20 hours of online tuition per week (4 hours of daily classroom study)
- 60-minute timetabled lessons
- Full range of Bishopstrow subjects, including English, PSHE, Mathematics, Science, History, Geography and Art (Key Stage 3) and English, PSHE, Mathematics, Science, History, Business Studies and Global Perspectives (Key Stage 4)
- Independent learning opportunities
- Daily 'prep' consisting of 30 minutes per subject per week (excluding Art and Global Perspectives)
- Targeted assessment of students' work
- Weekly English reading or writing test on Saturdays



Boarding Preparation

Sessions on what to expect as a boarder in a British boarding school, including:

- Fulfilling boarding house roles and responsibilities
- Managing structured and independent time
- Getting involved in boarding life and activities
