EXAM RESULTS

In 2021, 98% of grades awarded in IGCSEs were A* to C (equivalent to Grades 9-4), with 69% of grades awarded being Grades A* to A (equivalent to Grades 9-7)

Extra-Curricular Programme

The College's Extra-Curricular Programme includes a range of daily sports and evening clubs and activities, which help students develop skills as a team player and gain the confidence to join in with others when they move on from Bishopstrow. - Arrange practice tests and interviews and give advice about how to get the best results.
